BIOGRAPHY

Grr is an Italian producer currently based in Berlin. He introduces himself to the music scene in 1997, singing and playing the bass guitar in several experimental and industrial bands. Afterwards in 2001 he discovers the rave scene and starts to get closer to electronic music. He begins playing hardcore, industrial and tekno music in free parties using different analogic machines. In 2007 he starts producing with softwares like Ableton Live, Propellerhead Reason, Fruity Loops, Logic Pro, etc.. His style keeps developing to more experimental genres like breakcore and his hybridation with industrial and hardcore, being always sure to destroy the dancefloor and mess up your brain with fast pace breaks, glitched out fx and rude hardcore kicks to rip thru any speaker. He played with many major artists and in countless parties all over Europe. His music can be found on several labels like: Industrial Strength Records, Peace Off, Mechanical Brain, Mechanical Brain Limited, Sub/Version, Cheeze Graterz, Rxstnz, Jigsore, Sociopath Recordings, Viral Conspiracy, Damaging Waves, Iliphabetik, RusZud and Turn It Off Records. He also produced a couple of sample packs based on industrial, hardcore, breakcore, hard drum n bass and glitch styles.

Infernal Noise falls into the Hardtekno/Industrial's world, clubs and free parties in early 2004 and at the same time becomes part of "Industrial Move". He begins to compose with Cubase and helped by a background as electronic technician, he builds his own DIY instruments. In 2006 he establish, together with Ized, a new Hard Techno/Industrial's label called "Cyberknife Records" and starts to produce his own vinyls. In 2010, closing the experience with Industrial Move Crew, he decides to create a new label called "MECHANICAL BRAIN" and its sub-label "DARK MECHANISM" for experimental music. He played with many djs including The Deathmaker, Virus X Budburnerz, David Lagon, Hibou, Speedyq's, Armaguet Nad,
